The link helps victims of domestic and sexual abuse to access specialist support and information quickly and safely through partner websites without

leaving a 'digital footprint' or browsing history.

The concept was developed during the early days of the Covid-19 pandemic in response to the rising numbers of domestic abuse victims trapped at home with their abusers and has continued to grow.
